Salt is a mineral

As a mineral, salt has no place in a regulation focused on the science of living organisms.

Salt in the Organic Regulation is a contradiction and it would confuse consumers.

Public opposition

Neither consumers nor most producers ever asked for "organic salt". The European Parliament already vetoed proposal rules in 2023, and public consultations showed strong opposition.

Harmful Impact

The Organic Regulation contradicts the objectives of the EU Farm to Fork Strategy. It would exclude the majority of the salt industry from organic production, making organic salt unavailable in most EU Member States.

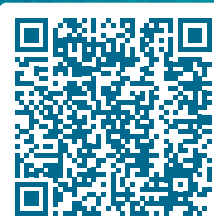
OUR ASKS
